



Potential exporter emails intent to export



Exporter submits to the Permit Office import requirements
from the Importing country



VSD Reviews requirements
(VSDL, Epidemiologist, NEPA, Fisheries Division)

LIVE ANIMALS



VSD IS CAPABLE OF FULFILLING THE EXPORT CRITERIA OF THE DESTINATION COUNTRY

Exporter completes application for Export Health Certificate Form

Pre-export quarantine starts (testing, treatment and vaccine requirements)

IF ANIMAL IS POSITIVE FOR DISEASE THE PROCESS STOPS HERE!

Preparation export (zoo-sanitary) Certificate of Health

Embarkation and Loading

Animals examined at point of loading


Embarkation certificate signed and stamped

TERRESTRIAL ANIMAL PRODUCTS

FOOD PROCESSING FACILITIES ARE REGISTERED AND MONITORED BY THE VSD AS APPROVED FACILITIES FOR EXPORT

SUBMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR EXPORT FROM IMPORTING COUNTRY .
REVIEWED BY VSD (VSDL, EPIDEMIOLOGIST)



EXPORTER SUBMITS LAB REPORTS;
MICROBIAL ANALYSIS; COMMERCIAL
STERILITY TESTING
